URGENT MEETING TO DISCUSS NEW Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority (VRQA) RREGULATION FOR VCE PROVIDERS

All community languages Schools VCE Providers are invited to attend a very important meeting of community languages schools in Victoria that offer VCE to discuss the new regulations being implemented by The Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority (VRQA).

A representative of the VRQA will attend the meeting to explain the process.

This is a new requirement under the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006* for all organisations delivering accredited senior secondary qualifications such as the VCE, VCAL or IB Diploma in Victoria to be registered with the VRQA;
Registration is also required to deliver an accredited senior secondary course such as a LOTE study (Units 1 – 4) which leads to the award of the VCE.

Your attendance at the meeting is critical, as your school will need to be part of the process.
