- Implemented the funding for after hours Community Language Schools
- Support for the then State-wide Resources Centre which is now known as the Languages and Multicultural Education Centre LMERC, a hub for language teachers from all systems is a legacy she left . Some wanted to close it – She stood strong and said NO!

- Today Victoria is the leader in language education –Joan Kirner was one of the politicians over time who provided the solid building blocks for this to occur.
- She left your mark and was a pioneer who can now quietly say:
"I did my bit to support languages education and communities and I am proud of this achievement!"
- Joan Kirner was the very first Premier to visit an Ethnic School in our State, in her electorate of Williamstown at the Yarraville campus of Omiros College, where thousands of students developed their Greek language.
